Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at THE Hilton Garden Inn, located at 86 South Rockford Drive, Tempe, Arizona 85281, commencing on November 9, 2022 at 10:00 a.m., and will continue as necessary on November 10, 2022, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website at <https://www.superstitionenergystorage.com/> and the ACC website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on November 9, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman,

1 the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on November 9,
2 2022, when it will continue after 5:00 p.m. for the public comment session.

3 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
4 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
5 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
6 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
7 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set
8 forth above.

12 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and

27 **ALSO BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE**
28 **DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.**

- 16 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the
17 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
18 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
19 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
20 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
21 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
22 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 23 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
24 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
25 environmental compatibility;
- 26 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
27 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
28 environmental compatibility;
10. Adjournment.
