**AMENDED AGENDA**

22 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the  
23 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting  
24 Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the  
25 above application that is open to the public at the Phoenix Plaza Conference Facility  
26 located at 2909 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85012, commencing on January  
27 22, 2020 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on January 23, 2020 through  
28 January 24, 2020, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day,  
unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on January 27, 2020, at  
approximately 11:00 a.m. or an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the  
Committee ("Chairman"). The hearing will thereafter commence at the Riggles RV and  
Event Center located at 240 North Riggles Avenue, Quartzsite, Arizona 85346 on January  
27, 2020 beginning at 4:00 p.m. and will continue on January 28, 2020 beginning at 9:00  
a.m. The hearing will then continue on February 6, 2020 at the Phoenix Plaza Conference

1 Facility located at 2909 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85012 beginning at  
2 10:00 a.m. and continue through February 7, 2020, as necessary, at that location beginning  
3 at 9:00 a.m. Public comment will be taken in two special evening sessions, first on  
4 January 22, 2020 beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the Phoenix Plaza Conference Facility, 2909  
5 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85012 and second on January 27, 2020  
6 beginning at 5:30 p.m. at the Riggles RV and Event Center, 240 Riggles Avenue,  
7 Quartzsite, Arizona 85346. Public comment may be taken at the beginning of each hearing  
8 day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later  
9 ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day,  
10 except on January 22, 2020, when it will continue after 6:00 p.m. and January 27, 2020  
11 when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment sessions.

12 Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude earlier or  
13 later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of  
14 testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations  
15 by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of the Committee  
16 will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour  
17 the location of the proposed power plants and transmission lines for the project as set forth  
18 above.

19 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate  
20 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different  
21 order than listed as conditions require:

- 22 1. Call to order;
- 23 2. Roll call;
- 24 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 25 4. Hearing on the application;
- 26 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 27 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;

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- 1           7.     If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the members of the Committee will  
2           tour the project.  Members of the public may view a recreation of the  
3           Committee’s tour in the Applicant’s Virtual Tour.  Members of the public  
4           may also recreate the tour by vehicle using the hover points as provided in  
5           Exhibit DCR-9 in the Applicant’s Exhibit List filed January 14, 2020.  No  
6           testimony or discussion with or between Committee members about the  
7           application or matters relating to the application will take place, except on  
8           the record before a court reporter.  The Chairman will make any procedural  
9           decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 10          8.     Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of  
11          environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of  
12          environmental compatibility;
- 13          9.     Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the  
14          certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of  
15          environmental compatibility;
- 16          10.    Adjournment.

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
