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A **PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD** before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (Committee) regarding the Application of West Camp Wind Farm, LLC (West Camp or Applicant) for Certificates of Environmental Compatibility to authorize the West Camp Wind Gen-Tie Project (Project). The Project includes an up to 25-mile transmission line and associated interconnection facilities from the new Project substation(s) to either the existing Cholla Substation or a new switchyard at a line tap to the APS 345-kV Cholla-Mazatzal transmission line of which some portions of the transmission line may be built on double-circuit structures. All Project components are located in Navajo County, Arizona. A general location map of the Project is attached as Exhibit A.

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The hearing will be held at **the High Country Conference Center, located at 201 West Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, Arizona 86001. 9 recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. COVID-19

24 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
25 promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health, or
26 other biological values to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to


1 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the
2 area in which the Project is located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall,
3 not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to
4 Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200
5 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

6 The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other
7 persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at the
8 hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona
9 Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the
10 Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85007, not less
11 than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited
12 appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine
13 witnesses.

14 This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §§ 40-360 to 40-
15 360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No
16 substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the
17 Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC
18 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on
19 the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.

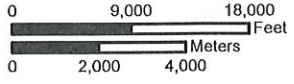

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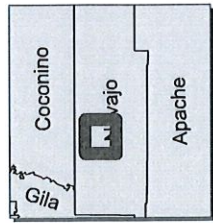


-  Gen-Tie Line Corridor to Cholla Substation
