Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Yuma Four Points by Sheraton, located at 2030 South Avenue 3E, Yuma, Arizona 85365, commencing on February 13, 2023 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on February 14, 2023, through February 15, 2023, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on February 13, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on February 13, 2023, when it will continue after 5:00 p.m. for the public comment session.

1 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the
