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Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Willcox Community Center, located at 312 West Stewart Street, Willcox, Arizona 85643, commencing on Monday, February 27, 2023 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, February 28, 2023, through Wednesday, March 1, 2023, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on February 27, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on February 27, 2023, when it will continue after 5:00 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and

8 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set  
9 forth above.

21           reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural  
22           decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

24           environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of

- 26           9.     Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the

28           environmental compatibility;
