
20 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
21 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
22 Committee ("Committee") that the Committee will hold a special meeting/hearing on the
23 above application that is open to the public beginning on Friday, December 17, 2010, at
24 1:30 p.m. The meeting/hearing is open to the public at the Arizona State Capitol Executive
25 Tower located at 1700 W. Washington St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007. The meeting/hearing
26 will be held in the basement of the Executive Tower in room B-56. The meeting/hearing will
adjourn as soon as the Committee decides how to resolve the issue regarding the
language of the Conditions of the Certificates of Environmental Compatibility. Depending
on the decision of the Committee, additional days for the hearing may be set. Some

1 members of the Committee may participate by telephone. The hearing may conclude
2 earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the time needed for deliberations by the
3 Committee. Public comment will not be taken during the hearing because of the nature of
4 the hearing. At the meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
5 and/or vote on the matters on the Agenda. Items on the Agenda may be taken in a different
6 order than listed as conditions require.
