14 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
15 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
16 Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the
17 above application that is open to the public at the Hampton Inn & Suites – Yuma, 1600
18 E. 16th Street, Yuma, Arizona 85365, on Monday, September 12, 2016 at 9:30 a.m.,
19 and as necessary on Tuesday, September 13, 2016 at 9:30 a.m., unless a tour is
20 taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on Monday, September 12, 2016, at approximately
21 1:30 p.m. or an alternative date and time set by the Chairman. Public comment may
22 be taken during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later
23 ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each
24 day.

25 Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude
26 earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene,
27 the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time
28 needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing,

1 members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the
2 discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed power plants and
3 transmission lines for the project as set forth above.


4 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
5 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a
6 different order than listed as conditions require:

- 7 1. Call to order;
- 8 2. Roll call;
- 9 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 10 4. Hearing on the application;
- 11 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 12 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 13 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the
14 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
15 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
16 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
17 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 18 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
19 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of environmental
compatibility;
- 20 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
21 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
22 environmental compatibility; and
- 23 10. Adjournment.
