Section 40-252 to reopen and amend Decision No. 70127 (Line Siting Case No. 135) which granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility for its Palo Verde Hub to North Gila Transmission Line Project to Modify the location and corridor width for a segment of the approved route and to approve the use of Y-Pole structures – Chairman Bob Stump and Commissioner Bitter Smith
