Commission Adds Subscription Capability to *eDocket** System


PHOENIX, AZ— The Corporation Commission’s eDocket system has been upgraded to allow for easier navigation. As part of this upgrade, an eDocket Subscription Service has been introduced for users to subscribe to updates on dockets of interest. The service has been implemented using RSS, a proven technology for distributing information over the Internet.

Subscribing to a docket automatically informs the subscriber of docket status changes, CC&N status changes, new document filings (including decisions), and the scheduling information of key docket events that appear in the eDocket Calendar. Following are instructions on how to sign up for this service:

Clicking on the RSS icon  will navigate to the eDocket Subscription Service. The eDocket Subscription Service can be accessed in a few ways.

- From the home page: a hyperlink will take you to a listing of recently created docket feeds. From this listing, you can navigate to a docket of interest. In addition, you can subscribe to this listing and be informed whenever new dockets are added to the database.
- From the docket search results data grid: an RSS icon appears in each row of the data grid, and clicking on the icon will take you to the RSS feed for the docket of interest.
- From the docket record page: an RSS icon appears at the top of the Docket record screen, and clicking on the icon will take you to the RSS feed for that docket.

Once you are on the RSS feed page for a docket of interest, clicking on the “Subscribe to this feed” hyperlink will bring up a dialog box:



Click the “Subscribe” button will add that feed to your browser’s RSS feeds. If you have Microsoft Outlook 2007, the feed will be added there as well giving you email notifications.

In addition to the subscription service, Data Grids have been employed to enhance navigation and provide sort-by-column capability to make it easier to find information. Clicking on the magnifying glass icon  in a grid will navigate to the record of interest.

QuickSearch, the text box in the upper right of most eDocket screens, has also been upgraded in two key areas. Users can now perform a search on a document barcode number. And, if a search returns only a single record, the system navigates directly to that record. Previously, such a search would display the record on the search results screen, requiring you to click to get to the record.

**eDocket* is an electronic docket information management system accessible via the web that can be found at <http://edocket.azcc.gov/edocket/>.

With eDocket, users can:

- Search dockets and view & print filed documents in open and closed cases
- Monitor Dockets using the eDocket Subscription Service
- Find and view ACC Calendar events
- Run reports on Pending Matters, Decisions, New Applications, and Filings.
