Commission Mourns the Passing of Ken Rozen

PHOENIX—The Arizona Corporation Commission mourns the passing of long-time employee and friend, Ken Rozen, who passed away unexpectedly Friday night.

“Ken was one of the few true friends that I’ve ever had,” said **Mike Gleason**, former Commission Chair. “We never had a major disagreement.”

“Ken was an incredibly valuable member of the Commission Staff who brought us insight, knowledge of the state’s public lands and cultural resources, sage advice on utility matters and most of all, his friendship,” **Commissioner Kris Mayes** said. “He will be missed throughout the ACC.”

“The passing of Ken Rozen is a loss to the entire Commission,” said **Commissioner Gary Pierce**. “Ken was a professional and thorough employee. He was a good person and a good person to work with. I will miss him.”

Ken came to the Commission in 2003, first serving as the Commission’s Government Affairs and Legislative Representative. In 2004, he took a position as Policy Advisory to then-Chairman Mike Gleason, where he served until the end of Gleason’s term in January 2009. Since that time, Ken has served as a consultant with the Commission, providing testimony and lending his considerable knowledge and expertise on several cases that have come before the Commission.

Prior to his tenure with the Commission, Ken served as Legislative Liaison to the Arizona Land Department, and had previously worked for the Arizona State Museum as an Archeological and Research Specialist.

He will be greatly missed. Our thoughts and prayers are with his wife, Carol during this difficult time.
