Corporation Commission Now Streaming Online Video of Hearings in Tucson

PHOENIX—In a continuing effort to provide the public greater access, the Arizona Corporation Commission is now able to provide streaming video of hearings and Open Meetings that are held in its Tucson offices. This feature will be a great benefit to customers of Southern Arizona utility companies, who would like to learn more about Commission proceedings and be more involved, but may not have the time or resources to attend the hearings in person.
