Commissioners Approve Application that Helps Growth in West Valley

Arizona Corporation Commissioners approved an application by EPCOR Water to provide wastewater services in a 4,417 acre area of Maricopa County close to Luke Air Force Base and the Loop 303.

That area is bordered by Peoria Avenue and Camelback Road from the north to south and Cotton Lane to Litchfield Road to the east and west.

It is an area slated for new development. There are 20 parcels in that area. The first three expected to be developed are three residential developments known as Granite Vista, Cordillera, and Allen Ranches.

EPCOR is the largest privately owned and publically regulated water and wastewater utility in Arizona serving 135,000 water and 50,000 wastewater connections in the Phoenix Metro area, Lake Havasu City, Bullhead City, and Tubac.

Commissioners Grant Bill Credit to UNS Gas Customers

UNS Gas customers will soon see a credit on their bill thanks to quick action by the Arizona Corporation Commission.

UNS GAS serves customers mostly in northern Arizona and to the east of the Phoenix Metro Area.

A surplus resulted due to lower than forecasted prices for natural gas. The Corporation Commission approved a temporary rate adjustment that will take effect November 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016. This will provide a lower bill during the winter and spring months when gas bills are typically highest.

On average, residential customers will see their monthly bills reduced by \$7.20 during that time frame.
