Commission Chairman Doug Little and Commissioner Andy Tobin to Attend Arizona Energy Conference

(Phoenix) The Arizona Corporation Commission will participate in an energy conference sponsored by the Arizona Competitive Power Alliance on March 16th in Scottsdale. The Arizona Energy Conference will be held at the Camelback Inn and will feature energy experts from around the country, including keynote speaker Former Interior Secretary Ken Salazar.

Chairman Doug Little and Commissioner Andy Tobin will both speak at the conference, offering their perspectives of the current state of the industry and the challenges moving forward with the influx of more renewable energy in the market place.

“This year we expect to initiate or complete rate cases involving at least five major electric companies, three major water utilities, and our largest natural gas utility. Next month we will begin hearings on the Value and Cost of Solar,” said Chairman Doug Little. “We have a unique opportunity here in Arizona to demonstrate real policy leadership that will guide the industry nationally. It will take hard work, innovation, and compromise, but I believe that we can get it done if we all work collaboratively.”

Representatives from APS, SolarCity, and Arizona Department of Environmental Quality will also give presentations.

The conference will run from 9:00 a.m. until 3 p.m. at the Camelback Inn at 5402 East Lincoln Drive in Scottsdale on Wednesday, March 16th.
