January 26, 2010, at 9:30 a.m. If the hearing has not concluded, it will continue on


1 Wednesday, January 27, 2010, at 8:00 a.m., if a tour is taken, otherwise it will begin at 9:00
2 a.m. The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. on each day. Public comment will be
3 taken during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Public comment also will be
4 taken in a special evening session on January 26, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. at the same location.
5 Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude earlier or later than
6 anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony
7 presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the
8 Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss
9 the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion of the Chairman of the Committee, may
10 tour the proposed route for the project on January 27, 2010, beginning at 8:00 a.m. At the
