24 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the  
25 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting  
26 Committee ("Committee") that the Committee will hold a meeting/hearing on the above


1 applications, that have been consolidated for purposes of hearing, that is open to the public  
2 at the Dateland Elementary School, located at 1300 South Avenue 64E, Dateland, Yuma  
3 County, Arizona, 85333, (just North of the Dateland Exit off Interstate 8) telephone number:  
4 (928) 454-2242. The hearing will begin on Tuesday, July 21, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. It will  
5 continue on Wednesday, July 22, 2009, at 8:00 a.m., if a tour is taken, otherwise it will  
6 begin at 9:30 a.m. If the hearing has not concluded, it will continue on Thursday, July 23,  
7 2009, beginning at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. on each  
8 day. Public comment will be taken during the hearing at times designated by the  
9 Chairman. Public comment also will be taken in a special evening session on July 21,  
10 2009, at 6:00 p.m. at the same location. Additional days for the hearing may be set, or the  
11 hearing may conclude earlier than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that  
12 intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time  
13 needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing,  
14 members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the discretion  
15 of the Chairman of the Committee, may tour the proposed power plant location and  
16 transmission line route for the project on July 22, 2009, beginning at 8:00 a.m. At the  
17 meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate and/or vote on the  
18 matters on the Agenda. Items on the Agenda may be taken in a different order than listed  
19 as conditions require.

- 14 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 15 4. Hearing on the application;
- 16 5. Public Comment;
- 17 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 18 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will travel along the  
19 route, following an itinerary which will be available at the hearing. A detailed  
20 description of the tour route and itinerary, including a map, will be on file at the  
21 Arizona Corporation Commission. Members of the public may follow the  
22 Committee's tour by use of their own private vehicles. No testimony or  
23 discussion with or between Committee Members about the Application or  
24 matters relating to the Application will take place, except on the record before a  
25 court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman of the Committee will  
26 make any procedural decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

- 1 8. Discussion of proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, the Certificate of  
2 Environmental Compatibility and conditions to the Certificate of Environmental  
3 Compatibility;  
4 9. Vote and decision concerning Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, the  
5 Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and conditions to the Certificate of  
6 Environmental Compatibility; and,  
7 10. Adjournment.
