
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20 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
21 general public, the parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
22 Committee ("Committee") that the Committee will hold a meeting/hearing on the above
23 application that is open to the public at the Hampton Inn & Suites, 2000 North Litchfield
24 Road, Goodyear, Arizona, 85395, (623) 536-1313, beginning on Monday, December 6,
25 2010, at 9:30 a.m., continuing on Tuesday, December 7, 2010, at 9:30 a.m., and, if
26 necessary, on Wednesday, December 8, 2010, at 9:30 a.m. If a tour if a tour is taken, it will
begin on December 7, 2010, at 8:00 a.m. or December 8, 2010, beginning at 8:00 a.m. The
hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. on each day. Public comment will be taken
during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. A public comment session will be

1 held on Monday, December 6, 2010, beginning at 6:00 p.m. Additional days for the hearing
2 may be set, or the hearing may conclude earlier than anticipated, depending upon the
3 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
4 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
5 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
6 at the discretion of the Chairman of the Committee, may tour the proposed transmission
7 line route for the project on December 7, 2010, December 8, 2010, beginning at 8:00 a.m.,
8 or at a later time. A decision about whether a tour will be taken on will be made during the
9 meeting/hearing the day before on December 6, 2010, or December 7, 2010. At the
10 meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate and/or vote on the
11 matters on the Agenda. Items on the Agenda may be taken in a different order than listed
12 as conditions require.

- 15 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 16 4. Hearing on the application;
- 17 5. Public Comment;
- 18 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 19 7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will travel along the
20 route, following an itinerary which will be available at the hearing. A copy of the
21 itinerary and tour route map will be filed at the Arizona Corporation
22 Commission. Members of the public may follow the Committee's tour by use of
23 their own private vehicles. No testimony or discussion with or between
24 Committee Members about the Application or matters relating to the Application
25 will take place, except on the record before a court reporter at the designated
26 stops. The Chairman of the Committee will make any procedural decisions
concerning what will be done at the stops during the tour;
