Commission Picks Tom Broderick to Lead Utilities Division

PHOENIX, AZ— After conducting a nationwide search, the Arizona Corporation Commission selected Tom M. Broderick to lead its Utilities Division. As Division Director, Broderick will oversee of staff of 60 utility regulatory experts and a \$5.5 million budget.

Broderick has more than 25 years of experience in electric, water and sewer utility regulation. For the last decade, Broderick has led regulatory teams for water companies. He has also worked for electric companies with business in Arizona, New Mexico, and Colorado.

Broderick brings international development experience as well, most recently spending a year in Kenya and Liberia as a team leader in the “Power Africa” project, which seeks to improve the delivery of power this area of the world.

“Tom’s expert knowledge of complex utility regulation issues along with his experience managing regulatory teams makes him well suited to be our new Utilities Division Director.” Commission Chairman Susan Bitter Smith said. “I look forward to working with Tom to ensure we are bringing utility services to residents and businesses in an efficient and affordable manner.”

Broderick’s first day is Monday. He replaces Steve Olea, who retired after 32 years with the Commission.

“I am honored to return to Arizona and work for the Corporation Commission on the important issues of utility regulation,” Broderick said.
