Commissioner Andy Tobin is On the Road Again The Commission's Rural Corp Comm Tour Continues April 11 & 12 in Mohave County

(Phoenix) The Corporation Commission's Open Meeting will be "on the road" again with Commissioner Andy Tobin. Tobin began what will be an eight-month long Rural Corp Comm Tour in Yuma in March. On April 11th and 12th that Tour will visit Bullhead City and Kingman.

"I, along with my fellow Commissioners, was able to hear from the residents of Mohave County last week at our Public Comment Meeting concerning UNS Electric's proposed rate case," said Tobin. "For many residents, that may have been their first exposure to the Commission. The ACC regulates electricity, water, natural gas, corporate filings, securities, pipelines, railroads and more. We need the people in urban and rural communities to be equally engaged and let their voices be heard."

On April 11th, Tobin will host an Open House from 5-7 p.m. at the Bullhead City Council Chambers at 1255 Marina Boulevard in Bullhead City. That event will feature a presentation by Commissioner Tobin, along with presentations by UNS Energy, Mohave Electric Cooperative, and EPCOR Water. Residents will have a chance to ask questions and voice any concerns.

"This is an event that is critical for rural Arizona residents who may at times feel disconnected from business decisions that take place in Maricopa County," said Supervisor Hildy Angius. "We want to encourage our residents to be represented and know that their voice counts."

On April 12th, Commissioner will participate in the Commission's monthly Open Meeting at 10 a.m. via teleconferencing from the Mohave County Administration Building at 700 W. Beale Street in Kingman. Residents are encouraged to attend to see how the Commission operates.
