NOTICE OF HEARING

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A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Southline Transmission, L.L.C. ("Southline" or "Applicant") for modification of the existing Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("CEC 173") approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") in Decision No. 75978 (February 24, 2017), as amended by Decision No. 77890 (January 22, 2021), to authorize the rebuild of a 115 kilovolt ("kV") line to a double-circuit 230/345 kV configuration (the "Upgrade Section") for the Southline Transmission Project ("Project") in Cochise County and Pima County, Arizona. The scope of the public hearing will be limited to the Committee's consideration of (1) extending CEC 173 to include the entire Upgrade Section and (2) if CEC 173 is extended to include the entire Upgrade Section, then to delete Condition 31 from CEC 173 as moot.

The Upgrade Section will involve the upgrades to approximately 57 miles of an existing Western Area Power Administration 115 kV line, rebuilding it to a double-circuit 230/345 kV configuration. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The hearing will be held at the DoubleTree by Hilton Tucson - Reid Park, 445 South Alvernon Way, Tucson, AZ 85711. The hearing will begin on Monday, January 12, 2026, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue on Tuesday, January 13, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., and then will continue as necessary through Friday, January 16, 2026, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day through the completion of the hearing. PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON MONDAY, JANUARY 12, 2026, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE DOUBLETREE BY HILTON - REID PARK, 445 SOUTH ALVERNON WAY, TUCSON, ARIZONA 85711. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH HEARING DAY, OR AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON. The Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.

No tour is planned at this time. If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project and ACC websites. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning what is visible at stops and the relevance of the location and view to the Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. Public health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary. If the Committee decides not to take a tour, the hearing will continue as scheduled.

Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007.

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Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project are located that desires to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007.

The Committee may make other persons parties to the proceedings at any time. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of the Utilities Division, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007, and the Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.
