Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at Radisson Hotel Casa Grande located at 777 North Pinal Avenue, Casa Grande, Arizona, 85122, commencing on February 5, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on February 6 through February 7, 2024, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”). Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on February 5, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on February 5, 2024, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website

20 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

22 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
23 environmental compatibility;
- 24 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
25 certificate of environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
26 environmental compatibility;
- 27 10. Adjournment.
