Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Francisco Grande Hotel and Golf Resort located at 12684 West Gila Bend Highway, Casa Grande, Arizona 85193, commencing on Monday, August 12, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on Tuesday, August 13, 2024, through Friday, August 16, 2024, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken.

If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”). Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on Monday, August 12, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on August 12, 2024, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

1 If the Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a
2 map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the
3 Project website at <https://projectbellaaz.com> and the Arizona Corporation Commission's
4 ("ACC") website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>.

5 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
6 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
7 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
8 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
9 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set
10 forth above.

14 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and

19 hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members
20 of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion
21 with or between Committee members about the application or matters
22 relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court
23 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
24 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 25 8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
26 environmental compatibility and conditions to the certificate of
27 environmental compatibility;
