**AGENDA**

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Radison Hotel Casa Grande located at 777 North Pinal Avenue, Casa Grande, Arizona 85122, commencing on January 20, 2026, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on January 21, 2027, through January 23, 2026, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on January 20, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman,

1 the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on January 20, 2026,  
2 when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

3 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the  
4 Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and  
5 itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website  
6 at <https://www.nexteraenergyresources.com/eloy-valley-solar.html> and the Arizona  
7 Corporation Commission's ("ACC") website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/hearings-and-meetings>.

9 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the  
10 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public  
11 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public  
12 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,  
13 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set  
14 forth above.

15 **THE PUBLIC HAS THE OPTION TO PARTICIPATE BY EITHER**  
16 **WATCHING THE MEETING ONLINE OR LISTENING TO THE MEETING VIA**  
17 **TELEPHONE.**

18 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and  
19 telephone hearing access as well as any additional details regarding safety protocols or  
20 other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Applicant's Project website

22 at <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>. The Chairman may, at  
23 his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing,  
24 or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be  
25 resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE**  
26 **OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER,**  
27 **PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

2 **SESSION ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2026, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M., VIA**  
3 **TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE RADISON HOTEL CASA**  
4 **GRANDE LOCATED AT 777 N. PINAL AVENUE, CASA GRANDE, ARIZONA**  
5 **85122. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH**  
6 **HEARING DAY, OR AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING, AT THE**  
7 **DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.**

8           **THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE**  
9 **HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON.**

10           At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate  
11 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different  
12 order than listed as conditions require:

- 13           1.     Call to order;
- 14           2.     Roll call;
- 15           3.     Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 16           4.     Hearing on the application;
- 17           5.     Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 18           6.     Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 19           7.     If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the  
20               hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members  
21               of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion  
22               with or between Committee members about the application or matters  
23               relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court  
24               reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural  
25               decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
- 26           8.     Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of  
27               environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of  
28               environmental compatibility;

9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;

10. Adjournment.
