Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at Hon-Dah Resort Casino, located at 777 Highway 260, Pinetop, Arizona 85935, commencing on October 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday on October 21, 2025, through October 24, 2025, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Committee.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on October 20, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on October 20, 2025, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any
