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13 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the
14 general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting
15 Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the
16 above application that is open to the public at the High Country Conference Center,
17 located at 201 W. Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ, 86001, commencing on Monday, October
18 27, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday through Wednesday, October 29,
19 2025, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour
20 is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on alternative date and time set by Chairman of
21 the Committee (“Chairman”).

22 Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on October 27, 2025, at
23 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during
24 the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman,
25 the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on October 27, 2025,
26 when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

27 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the
28 Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any

4 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
5 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
6 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
7 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
8 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set
9 forth above.

17 reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural
18 decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;

20 environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of
21 environmental compatibility;
- 22 9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
23 certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate
24 of environmental compatibility;
- 25 10. Adjournment.
