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Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the High Country Conference Center, located at 201 W. Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ, 86001, commencing on Monday, October 27, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday through Wednesday, October 29, 2025, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on alternative date and time set by Chairman of the Committee ("Chairman").

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on October 27, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman.
