NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of West Camp Wind Farm II, LLC ("Applicant"), for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing the construction of the West Camp 2 Gen-Tie Project ("Project"), which will include a new transmission line and associated interconnection facilities in Navajo County to interconnect the West Camp 2 Wind Farm to the regional transmission grid.

Project facilities will support two interconnection options: an up to 25-mile-long 345- or 500-kV transmission line to the existing Arizona Public Service (APS) Sitgreaves Substation or an up to 10-mile-long 500-kV transmission line to a new switchyard on the existing Salt River Project (SRP) 500-kV Cholla-Sugarloaf-Coronado transmission line. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The hearing will be held at the **High Country Conference Center**, located at 201 W. Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ, 86001, **commencing on Monday, October 27, 2025, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday through Wednesday, October 29, 2025, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day. PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2025, AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE HIGH COUNTRY CONFERENCE CENTER, LOCATED AT 201 W. BUTLER AVENUE, FLAGSTAFF, AZ 86001. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.

THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON. At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and telephone hearing access as well as any additional details or other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Project website at: https://www.aes.com/west-camp-2-wind.

The Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC websites. NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.

Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning what is visible at stops and the relevance of the location and view to the Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour

for transcription.

Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is located that desires to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before October 27, 2025, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. The Committee, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings.

Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five (5) days before October 27, 2025. A person making a

limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code Rules R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. Substantive communication not in the public record may not be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.
