NOTICE OF HEARING

11 **A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD** before the Arizona Power Plant and
12 Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of West
13 Camp Wind Farm II, LLC (“Applicant”), for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility
14 authorizing the construction of the West Camp 2 Gen-Tie Project (“Project”), which will
15 include a new transmission line and associated interconnection facilities in Navajo County
16 to interconnect the West Camp 2 Wind Farm to the regional transmission grid.

17 Project facilities will support two interconnection options: an up to 25-mile-long
18 345- or 500-kV transmission line to the existing Arizona Public Service (APS) Sitgreaves
19 Substation or an up to 10-mile-long 500-kV transmission line to a new switchyard on the
20 existing Salt River Project (SRP) 500-kV Cholla-Sugarloaf-Coronado transmission line. A
21 map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

22 The hearing will be held at the **High Country Conference Center**, located at 201
23 W. Butler Avenue, Flagstaff, AZ, 86001, **commencing on Monday, October 27, 2025, at**
24 **1:00 p.m., and will continue each weekday through Wednesday, October 29, 2025, as**
25 **necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day.** If any revisions to
26 the hearing schedule are required, they will be noticed on the Project website at

5 **ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE HIGH COUNTRY CONFERENCE CENTER,**
6 **LOCATED AT 201 W. BUTLER AVENUE, FLAGSTAFF, AZ 86001. PUBLIC**
7 **COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE**
8 **HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.**

9 **THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE**
10 **HEARING VIA TELEPHONE, OR ATTEND IN PERSON.** At least 24 hours in
11 advance of the hearing, information regarding online and telephone hearing access as well
12 as any additional details or other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the

14 The Chairman may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be
15 announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and
16 place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and
17 ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE**
18 **GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING**
19 **IS NOT REQUIRED.**

20 If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary
21 of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website at:
22 <https://www.aes.com/west-camp-2-wind>. Members of the public may follow the
23 Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops on the
24 tour concerning what is visible at stops and the relevance of the location and view to the
25 Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during
26 the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour

1 for transcription.

10 Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that
11 desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set
12 for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities,
13 ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.


14 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to
15 promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or
16 other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to
17 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the
18 area in which the Project is located that desires to become a party to the proceedings shall,
19 not less than ten (10) days before October 27, 2025, file a Notice of Intent to Become a
20 Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona
21 85007. The Committee, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties
22 to the proceedings.

23 Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in
24 writing with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix,
25 Arizona 85007, not less than five (5) days before October 27, 2025. A person making a
26

1 limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-
2 examine witnesses.

3 This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) §§ 40-360 to
4 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code Rules R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. Substantive
5 communication not in the public record may not be made to any member of the Committee.
6 The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. §
7 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceeding on the matter before the
8 ACC must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.

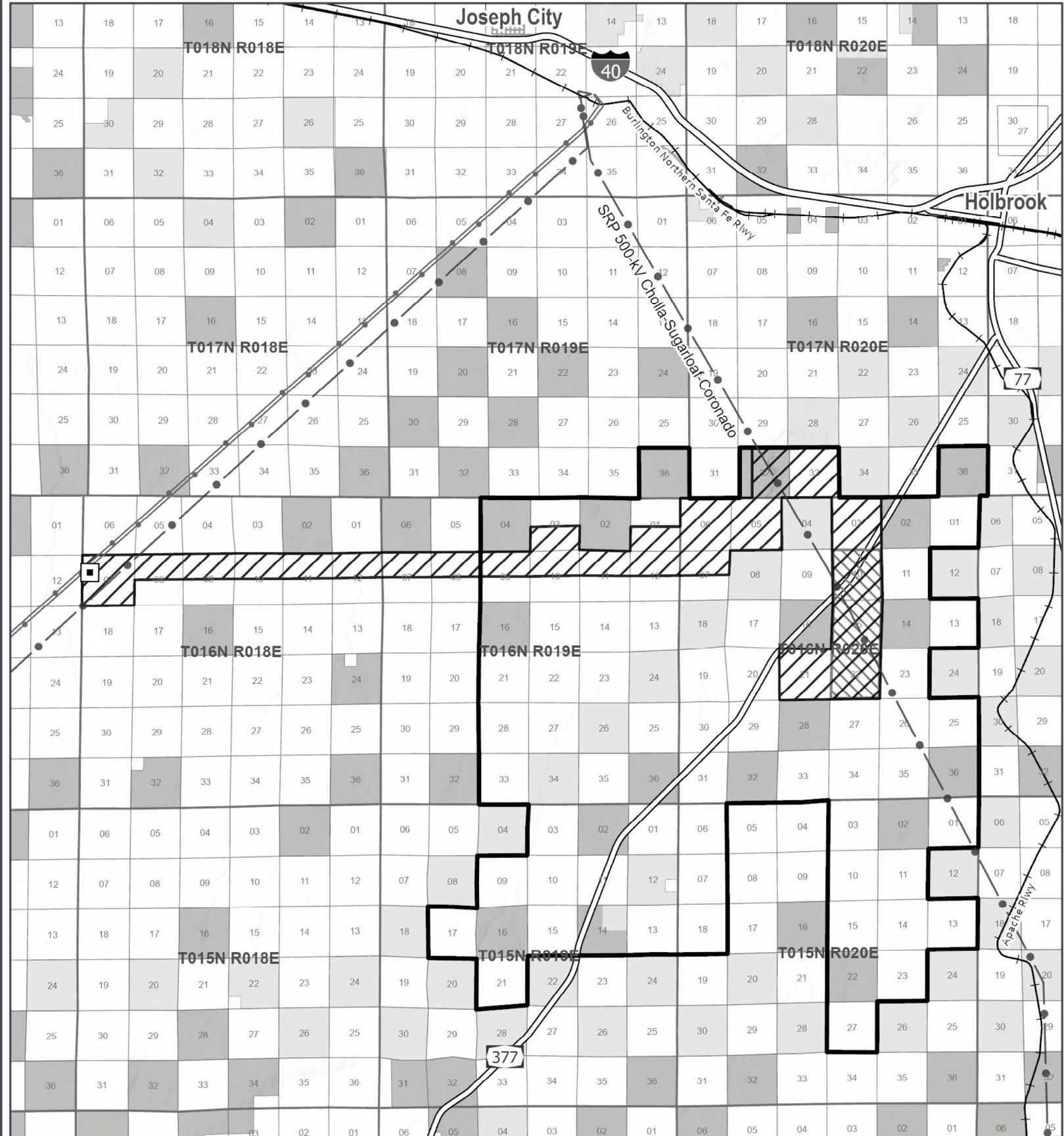

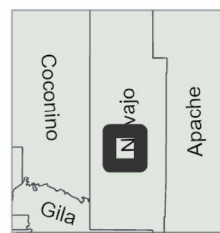
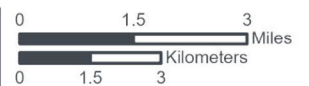
