A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Sawtooth Solar LLC ("Applicant") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility to authorize the Sawtooth Solar 230kV Generation Intertie Project ("Project"). The Project includes an approximately two-mile transmission line from the Sawtooth Solar energy facilities to the existing APS Milligan Substation. All Project components are located in Pinal County, Arizona. A general location map of the Project is attached as Exhibit A.

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21 The hearing previously scheduled for September 18, 2023, is vacated and rescheduled as discussed during the pre-hearing conference held September 12, 2023. 22 A.R.S. § 40-360.04(A) provides that "The chairman of the committee shall, within ten 23 days after receiving an application, provide public notice as to the time and place of a 24 hearing on the application The hearing or hearings shall be held not less than thirty 25 26 days nor more than sixty days after the date notice is first given...." A.A.C. R14-3-208(C) provides in relevant part that "Public notice" means "two publications in a daily 27 or weekly newspaper of general circulation within the general area in which the proposed 28

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plant or transmission line is proposed to be located." Taken together, A.R.S. § 40-360.04 1 and A.A.C. R14-3-208 require that both publications of the notice of the hearing occur 2 within ten days of the Chairman receiving the application and at least 30 days before the 3 hearing. The rescheduled hearing will be held in the Commissioner Conference Room on the second floor of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC"), located at 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007. The rescheduled hearing will be held on Monday, October 30, 2023, beginning at 9:00 a.m. If any revisions to the hearing schedule are required, they will be noticed on the Project website at https://www.edfthe ACC website re.com/project/sawtooth-solar-and-storage/ and on at https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule.

PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL SESSION ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2023, BEGINNING AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE, ZOOM, OR IN PERSON AT THE ACC, 1200 W. WASHINGTON STREET, PHOENIX, ARIZONA, 85007. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE OR THE HEARING OFFICER.

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health, or other biological values to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Committee, the Chairman, or the Hearing Officer, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a 27 limited appearance at the hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of 28

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Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the Chairman of
the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less than five (5)
days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance will not be
a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and A.A.C. R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee or the Hearing Officer. After the public hearing before the Hearing Officer, the Committee will review the record and make a decision in a subsequent open meeting that will be noticed on the Project website. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.RS. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
