



NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of 311SV 8me LLC, for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility ("CEC") authorizing construction of a 34.5/230kV substation and an approximately 7.4-mile long 230kV gen-tie transmission line (collectively, the "Catclaw Gen-tie Project" or "Project") interconnecting a proposed photovoltaic (PV) solar generating and battery storage facility to the existing APS Sun Valley Substation in Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Maricopa County, Arizona. A map of the location of the Catclaw Gen-tie Project is attached here as "Exhibit A".

The hearing will be held at the **Hilton Garden Inn**, located at 11460 W. Hilton Way, Avondale, AZ 85323, Telephone: 623-882-3351. The hearing will begin on **Wednesday, June 7, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. and continue as necessary on Thursday, June 8, 2023 and Friday, June 9, 2021 at 9:30 a.m.** The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day or earlier at the discretion of the Committee Chairman.

PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN AT A SPECIAL EVENING SESSION ON JUNE 7, 2023, AT 5:30 P.M., VIA TELEPHONE OR IN PERSON AT THE HILTON GARDEN INN, 11460 W. HILTON WAY, AVONDALE, AZ 85323. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY ALSO BE TAKEN AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ALL LOCAL AND STATE PUBLIC 9 HEALTH AND SAFTEY GUIDELINES WILL BE FOLLOWED DURING THE 10 HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION. RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLIC 11 ACCESS, ADDITIONAL SAFETY PROTOCOLS, AND REVISIONS TO THE 12 HEALTH HEARING **SCHEDULE** MAY OCCUR DUE TO PUBLIC 13 CONSIDERATIONS. 14

THE PUBLIC HAS THE OPTION TO PARTICIPATE BY EITHER 15 WATCHING THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTENING TO THE HEARING VIA 16 TELEPHONE, OR ATTENDING IN PERSON. At least 24 hours in advance of the 17 hearing, information regarding online and telephone hearing access, as well as any 18 additional details regarding safety protocols or other revisions to the hearing schedule will 19 be noticed on the Project website at https://www.catclawsolar.com. The Chairman may, at 20 his discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or 21 to be determined after the recess. The date, time and place at which the hearing will be 22 resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project website and the ACC website. 23

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If the Committee decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project and ACC websites. Members of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may hear testimony at stops concerning elements of the Project. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for transcription. Public health and safety protocols specific for the tour will be included on the itinerary.

The Applicant will make available final copies of the pre-filing conference, prehearing conference, and evidentiary hearing transcripts at each of the above locations and

Each county and municipal government and state agency interested in the Project and desiring to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 a notice of intent to be a party.

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation of natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the

area in which the Project are to be located and desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before June 7, ,2023, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 a notice of intent to be a party.

The Committee or its Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceeding. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five days before the date set for hearing. A person making a limited appearance shall not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication not in the public record may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on these matters before the Arizona Corporation Commission must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
