Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Comfort Suites Goodyear – West Phoenix located at 15575 West Roosevelt Street, Goodyear, Arizona 85338, commencing on Monday, August 31, 2026, at 11:00 a.m., and will continue each weekday on September 1, 2026, through September 4, 2026, as necessary, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day.

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on August 31, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”). Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on August 31, 2026, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and

4 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
5 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
6 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
7 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee may discuss the potential value of a tour.

9 **WATCHING THE MEETING ONLINE OR LISTENING TO THE MEETING VIA**
10 **TELEPHONE.**

11 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and
12 telephone hearing access as well as any additional details regarding safety protocols or
13 other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Applicant's Project website

15 <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/meeting-schedule>. The Chairman may, at his
16 discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing or to
17 be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be
18 resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project and ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE**
19 **OF ANY SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER,**
20 **PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

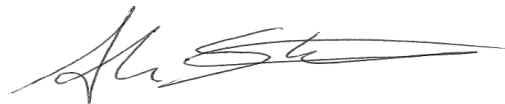
28 **THE PUBLIC CAN WATCH THE HEARING ONLINE, LISTEN TO THE**

1 At the public meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate,
2 and/or vote on the matters on the agenda. Items on the agenda may be taken in a different
3 order than listed as conditions require:

- 4 1. Call to order;
- 5 2. Roll call;
- 6 3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
- 7 4. Hearing on the application;
- 8 5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
- 9 6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
- 10 7. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of
11 environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of
12 environmental compatibility;
- 13 8. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the
14 certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate
15 of environmental compatibility;
- 16 9. Adjournment.
