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NOTICE OF HEARING

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A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of Mariposa Energy Park, LLC (“Applicant”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (“CEC”) to authorize the Mariposa Interconnection Project (“Project”).

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The Project includes an approximately 3.6-mile, 500 kilovolt (“kV”) generation intertie transmission line that will originate at the Mariposa Solar Energy Park, a proposed 412 MW photovoltaic solar and 125 MW battery energy storage facility, and extend south to a new line-tap on the existing Pinal West-Jojoba 500 kV transmission line, and a 24-acre, 500-kV switchyard located at the point of interconnection. A map of the Project is attached as **Exhibit A**.

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The hearing will be held at the Comfort Suites Goodyear-West Phoenix located at 15575 West Roosevelt Street, Goodyear, Arizona 85338. **The hearing will begin on Monday, August 31, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. and will continue as necessary through Thursday, September 4, 2026, beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day at the same location**

Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health, or other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is located desiring to become a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Committee may make other persons parties to the proceedings at any time. Any person may make a limited appearance at the hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85004, not less than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code R14-7-101 to R14-7-120. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. §

1 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before the
2 ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
