Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public, the parties, and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”), that the Committee will hold a public meeting/hearing on the above application that is open to the public at the Northwest Fire District Training Facility, 5125 W. Camino de Fuego, Tucson, Arizona 85743, commencing on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. and will continue as necessary through Friday, September 11, 2026, at the same location beginning at 9:00 a.m. on each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on an alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee (“Chairman”).

Public comment will be taken in a special evening session on September 8, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. and may be taken at the beginning of each hearing day or at other times during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Unless later ordered by the Chairman, the hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day, except on September 8, 2026, when it will continue after 5:30 p.m. for the public comment session.

1 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the
2 Chairman or Committee later decides to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and
3 itinerary of any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website
4 at <https://www.sunridge-power.com/> and the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("ACC")
5 website at: <https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-power-plant/hearings-and-meetings>.

6 The hearing may conclude earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the
7 number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public
8 comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public
9 meeting/hearing, members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and,
10 at the discretion of the Chairman, may tour the location of the proposed project area as set
11 forth above.

15 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and

17 other revisions to the hearing schedule, will be posted on the Applicant's Project website

20 a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess.
21 The date, time, and place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the
22 above-noted Project and ACC websites. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH RESUMED**
23 **HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A**

3. Consideration of and vote upon any requests to intervene;
4. Hearing on the application;
5. Public comment at the discretion of the Chairman;
6. Discussion of potential value of a tour of the proposed route;
7. If it is decided a tour would be valuable, the Committee will meet at the hearing site. The members of the Committee will tour the project. Members of the public may follow the Committee's tour. No testimony or discussion with or between Committee members about the application or matters relating to the application will take place, except on the record before a court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman will make any procedural decisions concerning stops at different points of interest;
8. Discussion of proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
9. Vote and decision concerning findings of fact, conclusions of law, the certificate of environmental compatibility, and conditions to the certificate of environmental compatibility;
10. Adjournment.
