

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, Notice is hereby given to the members of the 16 general public, the Parties and the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting 17 Committee ("Committee"), that the Committee will hold a meeting/hearing on the 18 above application that is open to the public at the Embassy Suites Hotel, located at 19 4400 South Rural Road, Tempe, AZ 85282, telephone: 480-897-7444. The hearing 20 will begin on Tuesday, September 16, 2014, at 9:30 a.m., and will continue on 21 Wednesday, September 17, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., unless a tour is taken. If a tour is 22 taken, it will begin on Wednesday, September 17, 2014, at 8:00 a.m., or at a later time 23 set by the Chairman of the Committee. If necessary, the hearing will continue on 24 Thursday, September 18, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. Public comment may be taken during the 25 hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Public comment also will be taken in a 26 special evening session on September 16, 2014, at 6:00 p.m., at the same location. 27 The hearings will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day except for September 28

1	16, 2014, when the hearing will continue until after the evening public comment
2	session. Additional days for the hearing may be set, and the hearing may conclude
3	earlier or later than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene,
4	the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time
5	needed for deliberations by the Committee. As a part of the public meeting/hearing,
6	members of the Committee will discuss the potential value of a tour, and, at the
7	discretion of the Chairman of the Committee, may tour the location of the proposed
8	power plants and transmission lines for the project on September 17, 2011, beginning
9	at 8:00 a.m. At the meeting/hearing, the Committee may consider, discuss, deliberate
10	and/or vote on the matters on the Agenda. Items on the Agenda may be taken in a
11	different order than listed as conditions require.

21	discussion with or between Committee Members about the Application or matters relating to the Application will take place, except on the record
22	before a court reporter at the designated stops. The Chairman of the Committee will make any procedural decisions concerning stops at different
23	points of interest;
