The natural gas distribution system on our property is defined as a master meter system in accordance with the definition as stated in the Arizona Administrative Code R14-5-205. As such, our pipeline system is subject to the safety requirements of Arizona Revised Statute 40-441 and Title 49, Part 192 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Part 192.616 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires us to develop and implement a written public awareness program that will inform the general public and you, as an emergency response agency, about the potential hazards associated with the transportation of natural gas, and how to recognize and report pipeline emergencies to the appropriate authorities to minimize hazards to life and property.

Enclosed is a copy of our pipeline system map that provides natural gas service on our property. Please note the location on the system map of the main shutoff valve on our natural gas system that is located on the master meter set owned and operated by \_\_\_\_\_.
